### **Legacy Preparatory Christian Academy Announces Expansions in Athletics Department**

Legacy Preparatory Christian Academy (Legacy Prep) of The Woodlands, TX is pleased to announce several upcoming additions to its Athletics Department. As the school reaches near completion of their permanent location on Research Forest Drive, it proves to be an exciting year for Legacy Prep. The school has experienced an average annual growth rate of over 25% and the Athletics Department is one of the many reasons for the continued increase in enrollment.

Founded in 2005, Legacy is comprised of grades pre-kindergarten through 12th. Legacy prepares students to be successful in college and life by providing a rigorous academic education that is rich in opportunities. Legacy is a University Model School certified by the National Association of University Model Schools (NAUMS), headquartered in Fort-Worth, Texas. Legacy is also accredited by AdvancEd/SACS – Southern Association of Colleges and Schools.

Legacy Prep's new home is located on a 25 acre site between Research Forest Drive and FM 1488. The main building will be approximately 55,000 square feet with 24 classrooms, administrative and business offices, cafeteria and gym. The gym will immediately allow Legacy Prep to host junior high and varsity basketball games and tournaments.

The school recently completed its football season in the TAPPS Division 3 District 4. The 6-man varsity team competed in the playoffs in only their second year of play. The junior high 6-man team finished their season undefeated in 6-man play for the third straight year. Legacy Prep will move to 11-man varsity play for the 2014 football season.

Another big highlight will be the completion of Legacy Prep's football field in the northwest corner of the property. The field is set to be ready for the fall 2014 season. "It will be such an honor and privilege for our students to have their own football field," said Matt Tarbutton, Legacy Prep Athletic Director. Sportscapers, Inc. has been contracted to build the football field and LED scoreboards have been sponsored by First Bank.

Several other additions to the Legacy Prep Athletics Department for the spring 2014 season include high school baseball, golf, and tennis. Junior high and high school volleyball will be added beginning fall 2014. "Increasing our sports offerings allows Legacy Prep to become more competitive among other private, Christian schools. This also affords our students greater opportunities to learn responsibility and positive sportsmanship," Tarbutton stated.

Legacy Prep already offers junior high and varsity football, junior high and varsity boys and girls basketball, junior high and varsity cheerleading, junior high and varsity boys and girls track, and varsity girls diving.
